Delivery charge of £8 for medication from Ely. Some questions from East Cambs have been received and are to be responded to as follows:

- Who is the lead officer - Graham James
- How many volunteers you have? - 35 from delivering to all 297 homes in the village
- What services are you providing - collection and distribution of medication, shopping, regular telephone contact, collecting and posting mail, dog walking and help with Internet.
- How are you contacting the vulnerable or identifying the vulnerable - knocking on doors, sending out a further letter to find out if there are more people to be found.
