1. 21/00716/FUL- The parish council **support** this application with no comments to make. It was **proposed** by Cllr Kirby and **seconded** by Cllr Clark and **resolved** by unanimous vote.
2. 21/00829/RMA- The parish council **support** this application but would like a clause implemented regarding the height of the fence on the Cemetery boundary. They ask if the occupants were to put decking up, the fence would be high enough to allow privacy within the Cemetery. The parish council also have concerns over the flood risk to the Cemetery extension and would like that matter investigated before the application is permitted. It was **proposed** by Cllr Kilby and **seconded** by Cllr Lamb and **resolved** by unanimous vote to **support** the application with the implementation of the clause and the investigation of flood risk.
3. 21/00830/RMA- The parish council **support** this application but would like a clause implemented regarding the height of the fence on the boundary of Little Acorns Pre-School to protect the privacy of the children. It was **proposed** by Cllr Kilby and **seconded** by Cllr Chamberlain and **resolved** by unanimous vote to **support** the application with the implementation of the clause. It was also **noted** that the clerk should advise Little Acorns to put any comments they have regarding plot 6 to ECDC before Friday 25th June.
